Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to those of you who were able to attend our Harvest Festival and Macmillan Coffee Morning on 27<sup>th</sup> September where together we raised £125.00, and thanks also to those of you who attended our Grandparents Day lunch last Friday. We hope you enjoyed both events.

#### Lincoln City Football

You will be aware that Lincoln City Football Club coaches are coming into school every Thursday at the moment to work with all our children. Thursday mornings are a very popular point in the week for the children, as they really enjoy their time with Coach James. As well as providing the children with some extra specialist coaching though, Lincoln City have also given School two season tickets for the 2024-2025 - one adult ticket and a junior seated next to each other. We know there are some avid football fans in school and so we hope that collectively we can make use of this opportunity. We are also planning a visit to Lincoln City Football ground in the Spring Term.

In the meantime, if you would like to make use of the season tickets, we have created a schedule of home games which is attached and all you have to do is let us know which match you would like to attend. There should be sufficient numbers for most children to attend a game. Allocations will have to operate on a 'first come first served' basis. The tickets will need to be collected from the Office, signed for, and returned the following working school day. Just to give you a flavour of what is available, Lincoln City play Birmingham City on 19<sup>th</sup> October, and are playing Stockport City on 26 October.

#### <u>Attendance</u>

This September revised government statutory guidance has come into force in all schools, in an attempt to improve national school attendance rates. Guidance now states that schools should not authorise attendance for recreational purposes such as a holiday in almost all circumstances. Furthermore, any child of school age is deemed to be 'persistently absent' if they miss ten sessions or more in a rolling period of ten school weeks. A session is a morning or afternoon in school.

An unauthorised holiday in term time of the duration of 5 days or more is therefore more likely to be subject to a fixed term penalty fine payable by each parent of £80 if paid within 21 days and £160 if paid within 28 days. We will be keen to offer support to all families when a student's attendance drops below 90% for any reason.

Our pupils' attendance at North Clifton Primary is good and I am grateful for the continued support of all parents, but please do think carefully before you book any recreational time away in term time.

Our Attendance Policy has been revised to reflect the new statutory guidance on attendance in school and was adopted by Governors on 9<sup>th</sup> October 2024. The new policy will be on our school website by the end of next week. An information sheet summarising the changes is attached and we hope this will be a helpful guide to parents and carers.

Our first Golden Assembly of the academic year takes place next Monday morning at 9.15am (14<sup>th</sup> October). Please invite friends and family to join us celebrate the achievements of the children so far this term.
